About Department of Pharmacy, NUS

Founded in 1905, the Department of Pharmacy is one of the pioneering department in the university. Being the only Pharmacy school in Singapore, we have close links with the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine and the National University Hospital. Now, the department is embarking on a strategic renewal to boost research and innovation.

The Department of Pharmacy at the National University of Singapore invites applicants for tenure track faculty positions as Assistant Professors. Candidates need not have degrees in Pharmacy or Pharmaceutical Sciences but their research areas should be relevant to the study of Pharmacy or Pharmaceutical Sciences. Successful applicants will receive a competitive remuneration package as well as a generous start-up grant.

The candidate must hold a PhD degree or equivalent in a relevant discipline and have an outstanding publication record, an exceptional potential for world class research and a commitment to both undergraduate and graduate education. The candidate is also expected to establish a competitive research program with external funding and/or industry collaborative projects.
